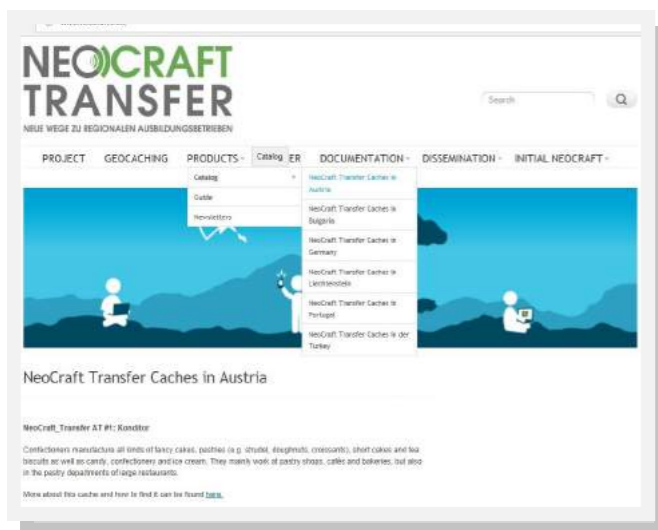

NeoCraft Transfer Guide as Compendium

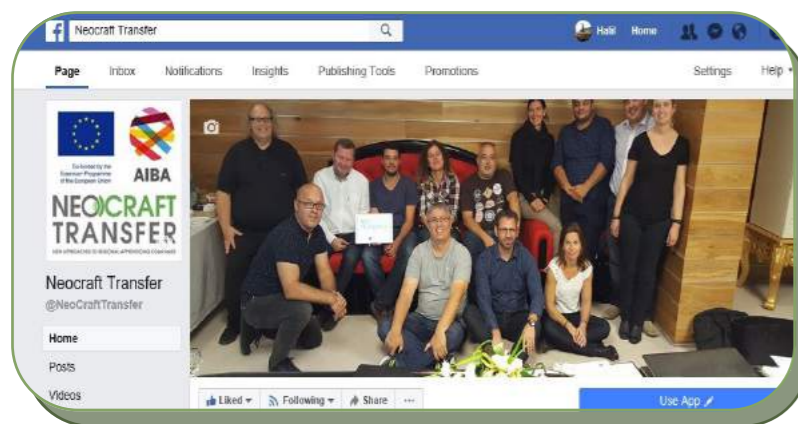
